

**MINUTES OF THE
STE. GENEVIEVE BOARD OF ALDERMEN
WORK SESSION
November 12, 2020**

The work session of the Ste. Genevieve Board of Aldermen was called to order at 7:15 p.m. with everyone present. (Alderman Donovan attending virtual.)

A motion by Alderman Prince, second by Alderman Eydmann to approve the work session agenda as presented. Motion carried 8-0.

FLOOD BUYOUT PROPERTY INSURANCE. The Property Maintenance Agreement for buy-out properties was recently updated to include a stipulation that the caretaker shall provide the City with proof of liability insurance showing the City of Ste. Genevieve as an additional insured. After passing this agreement it has been discovered that some insurance companies will not add the City as an additional insured. Therefore City Administrator Welch is recommending that the City update the agreement so that this is no longer a requirement. All were in favor and the proposed change will be brought to the Board at a future meeting. (The Community Garden is also asking that this insurance requirement be waived.)

LEVEE PROPERTY BUDGETING + NAMES FOR SIGNS. City Administrator Welch would like for the Board to establish a budget to be able to expend funds from the Capital Projects Fund to create signage along the levee for educational purposes, put in a parking area for vehicles, and cover the costs of a survey to be performed that will subdivide the property so that an approximate 70 acre pieces on the east side of the levee can be donated to the Fish & Wildlife Service. Also the board for future approval will need to consider approving the recommended names for the parking area (Stormy Crawford Way) , the borrow pit (Lake Audubon) , and the trail (Vern Bauman Trail) that extends east from the levee. The signs can then be printed and installed. The board recommended proceeding with the \$15,000 budget amendment and the signage as well.

With no further business the work session was adjourned at 7:40 p.m.
